



# Closing Inspiration

## Role Description

*Your job is to provide inspiration or something thought provoking for our club to end the meeting. This can be a story, a quote or a personal vision of motivation or something to inspire us to be our best selves.*

## Before the Meeting

- Choose something inspirational or thought provoking to share at the end of our meeting. If you wish, you can provide something relative to the meeting's theme.
- All functionaries will be emailed the meeting theme and a question about it. Come up with a response to share when the Toastmaster introduces you. Keep it to two sentences. Or you might choose not to give one, especially if we are running behind on time.

## Role Supplies

- The inspirational words and thoughts

## During the Meeting

- When called upon, provide your inspiration to the audience. You have a minimum of 30 seconds to a maximum of 1 minute for this.. Please note, at the discretion of the Toastmaster/Presiding Officer, this may be eliminated if the meeting is running long.

- Use this opportunity to work on your speaking skills and try to do it without notes. (Notes are fine if you need them.)
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
